Chairman’s Report-
Warren Kotzer

I am writing on behalf of the Family & Friends Community Foundation Board with a high

degree of emotion, optimism and accomplishment. Since 2003 when the Foundation was formed, with an interim board, we have moved forward with a solid business approach to managing and growing this foundation. We have created funds for health, culture and recreation because community minded people recognized the need in their respective communities.

We have moved through the past 7 years experiencing some great market conditions to some very poor ones. We all remember the years when markets were great and we were able to grant a lot of money back to our communities. However in 2008 and 2009, we were very restricted to what we could do. We have worked toward a more level granting agenda by restricting granting to a maximum (4%) in the good years and using the excess to build reserves for the years when markets are not so good. We are happy to report that all endowment balances have returned to the amount initially invested by contributors.

2010 was a very rewarding year for the board members. We accomplished the priority needs list from the Care Home that appeared to be mountainous when it was first brought to the board’s attention. A big **Thank You** to the contributors, board and committee members who stayed the course to get what looked to be an overwhelming task completed. In 2011, we are on our way to replacing the Freedom Rider used by many in our local communities, thanks

to the Golf for Health Committee and generous donations from contributors including our local government bodies.

2010 has seen the assets of The Foundation grow extensively through the generous contributions of new and past donors. A big **“Thank You”** to all of our donors for recognizing the work of The Foundation and how it is making things better in our communities.

The Directors and committees have been excellent to work with this past year. Again Carla Kaeding and Cheryl Kotzer have dedicated countless hours to the Foundation.

I have enjoyed this year as chairman. We know we are on a strong path of growth and improvement for the communities represented by Family & Friends Community Inc.

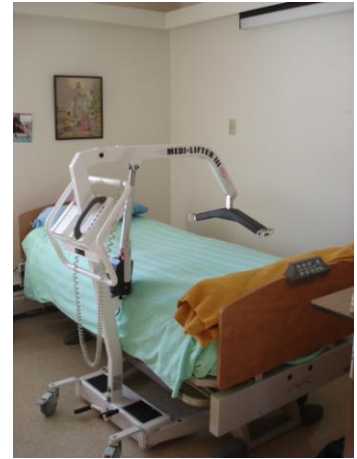

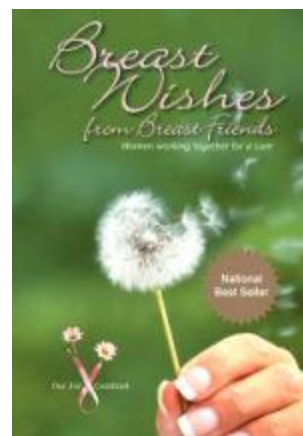
BREAST CANCER AWARENESS & EDUCATION FUND

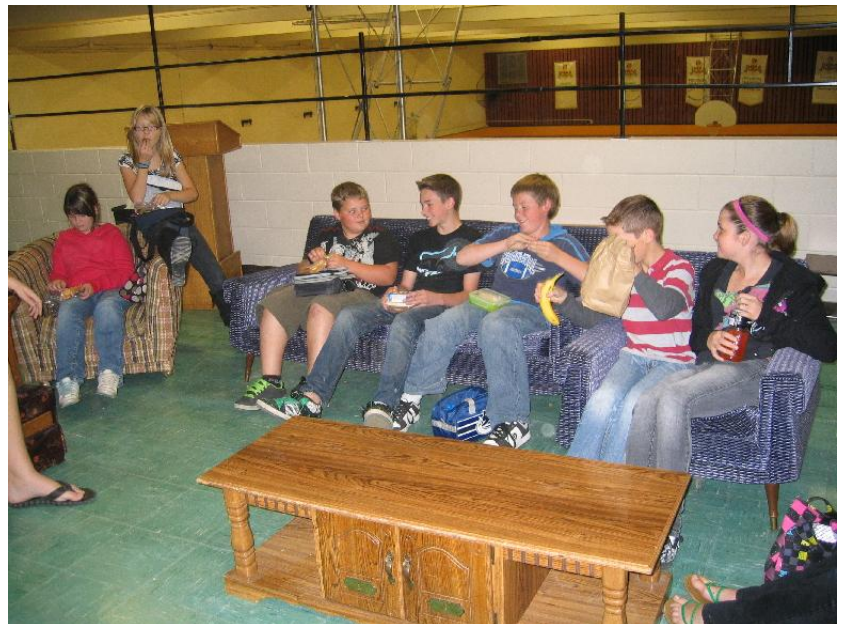
